Workshop on NEP 2020 – Detailed Summary of Talks by Resource Persons:

The Workshop on the "Implementation of NEP 2020 for Technical & Professional Education in Odisha" was the intellectual highlight of the event. The session brought together some of the most distinguished voices in higher education and policy to discuss the vision, strategic frameworks, and localized implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 in the state of Odisha. The session was structured as a series of keynote addresses and thematic reflections by four eminent resource persons.

Prof. Amiya Kumar Rath, Vice Chancellor, BPUT, Odisha

Prof. Rath focused on BPUT's roadmap for NEP 2020 implementation, outlining the administrative, academic, and digital steps already underway and those planned in the near future.

Key Highlights of his Talk:

Curricular Reforms: He discussed the university's initiative to redesign curriculum structures to incorporate multidisciplinary electives, skill-based modules, and research orientation from the undergraduate level.

Credit Transfer & ABC Adoption: Prof. Rath emphasized BPUT's active role in implementing the Academic Bank of Credits and encouraged colleges under its affiliation to align their records with the ABC portal.

NEP-Aligned Assessment Methods: He underlined the transition from rote-based exams to project-based, continuous, and outcome-oriented assessment.

Faculty Training & Capacity Building: Prof. Rath shared insights on the training of faculty members across Odisha through workshops, FDPs, and NEP sensitization programs.

Localized Strategy: He highlighted the need to contextualize NEP within Odisha's socio-economic and linguistic realities, emphasizing regional relevance alongside global alignment.

He encouraged institutions under BPUT to act as incubation centers of innovation and entrepreneurship.

Prof. Bibhuti Bhusan Biswal, Vice Chancellor, OUTR, Bhubaneswar

Prof. Biswal provided a pragmatic and infrastructure-centric perspective on NEP implementation, with a strong focus on collaboration and innovation ecosystems.

Key Highlights of his Talk:

Research and Innovation Emphasis: He emphasized the creation of research ecosystems in undergraduate institutions and encouraged joint industry-academia projects.

Inter-institutional Collaboration: Prof. Biswal advocated for resource sharing, joint conferences, and knowledge transfer between institutions across Odisha.

Technology Integration: He spoke about the need for digital infrastructure and encouraged the use of open educational resources, e-labs, and AR/VR tools to support immersive learning.

Institutional Autonomy and Governance: Prof. Biswal pointed out that autonomy should come with responsibility. He encouraged colleges to redefine their governance structures to become more transparent, accountable, and responsive to stakeholder needs.

His talk concluded with a call to action for institutions to embrace NEP not just as a policy mandate but as an opportunity to reinvent themselves.

Smt. Rashmita Panda, IAS, CEO, World Skill Centre, Bhubaneswar

Smt. Panda brought in a government and skills-sector perspective, focusing on the convergence of NEP 2020 with skill development and industry readiness.

Key Highlights of her Talk:

Skill-Linked Higher Education: She emphasized how NEP promotes the integration of skilling programs within the academic framework, enabling students to graduate with both degrees and employable skills.

World Skill Centre as a Model: She presented the World Skill Centre as a model of excellence in vocational and technical training, offering global-standard training to Odisha's youth.

Industry Collaboration: Smt. Panda stressed on developing institutional linkages with industries through centers of excellence, internship programs, and guest lectures.

Empowering Women and Rural Youth: She spoke about targeted policies and programs to bring rural and underrepresented youth, especially women, into mainstream higher education and employment.

She concluded by expressing the Odisha government's strong commitment to synergize NEP with the state's vision of a skilled, educated, and employable youth population.

Prof. T. G. Sitharam, Chairman, AICTE, New Delhi

Prof. T. G. Sitharam delivered the keynote address, focusing on the national vision and strategic thrusts of NEP 2020. His address was both comprehensive and visionary, outlining the structural transformation proposed under NEP and AICTE's role in its nationwide implementation.

Key Highlights of his Talk:

Holistic Multidisciplinary Education: Prof. Sitharam emphasized breaking down the silos in technical and professional education. He advocated for universities to adopt a multidisciplinary approach and encourage creativity, design thinking, and problem-solving across disciplines.

Flexible Curriculum with Multiple Entry/Exit Options: He elaborated on the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) and the importance of creating student-centric systems that promote lifelong learning.

Skill Integration and Employability: He highlighted the need to embed skill development within degree programs, linking theory with practical applications, internships, and apprenticeships.

Digital Transformation & AICTE's Initiatives: Prof. Sitharam spoke about the ongoing digitalization of higher education and AICTE's support for platforms like SWAYAM, AICTE IDEA Labs, and virtual learning environments.

Equity and Access: He emphasized inclusion and equal opportunities for rural and marginalized learners, aligning with the larger equity goals of NEP.

He concluded by urging all stakeholders in Odisha to be proactive, experimental, and collaborative in implementing NEP at the institutional level.

Each session was followed by an interactive Q&A round, where delegates and faculty members engaged the speakers in lively discussion, seeking clarifications and suggestions for practical implementation at the grassroots level.
