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# Report On "Blood Donation"

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#### **Background:**

The institute has put in consistent endeavors in deftly carrying out social responsibilities which prove beneficial to mankind at large. One such activity is the Blood Donation Camps organized by the institute. The camp serves multiple purposes for students and faculty involved.

- 1. The Need for the Camp: The purpose of education is not just making job ready students, rather it is to inculcate an unflinching sense of social welfare. The students at the institute learn this value by contributing to the social cause.
- 2. **The Contributors:** The activity is a centrally driven initiative that invites participation from faculty, students, administration and management.
- 3. The Planning and Execution: The delegation of responsibility flows from the apex members to student volunteers. The administration appoints one chief coordinator who builds his or her own team consisting of members of faculty and staff. A grand team of student coordinators and volunteers is also constituted for the field work. The institute has been successful in donating about 62 (approx.) of blood the blood bank every year.
- 4. The Celebration: The event begins with a grand inaugural ceremony organized by the cultural team. The day begins with a formal inauguration which hosts dignitaries from top-notch medical representatives. Eminent doctors and administrators from the health department participate as the distinguished guests to motivate the gathering.
- 5. Skills learnt- The event has been proved to be a milestone in shaping the personality of the students involved. Every engineer is expected to be trained in soft skills as well as the technical field that he or she belongs to. The students learn the essential tenets of teamwork, leadership, conflict resolution, decision making and many more.

Conclusion: The activity is a perfect example of working together for the social cause. Countless people have been benefitted over these years and the institute feels humbled to have helped them.

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Preamble: The first record of the voluntary blood donation initiative in India is noted in 1942, at the time of World War II and the first blood bank was established in Kolkata, West Bengal. The blood bank was set up at that time to fulfill the blood needs of those injured in the battle field. Government employees and industrial houses volunteered to donate blood for this humanitarian cause. Once the war ended, the enthusiasm waned and blood bank collections were largely from professional or the paid blood donors. A decade passed by till Mrs. LeelaMoolgaokar initiated voluntary blood donation drive in Bombay (now Mumbai) from 1954 onwards. She was inspired by the blood need of her injured son. In 1971, Prof. J.G. Jolly the founder President of the Indian Society of Blood Transfusion and Immunohematology took the movement to further heights and the Society under his stewardship declared October 1 as National Voluntary Blood Donation Day which was later accepted by the government too. Since then many blood donor organizations came up in different regions of the country in support of the noble cause of voluntary blood donation. The National Blood Policy (2002) and an Action Plan for Blood Safety (2003) were adopted by the Government of India. The NBTC (National Blood Transfusion Council) was entrusted with planning a national campaign.

There are four main blood types: A, B, AB and O. In 1901, Karl Landsteiner, an Austrian physician, discovers the first three human blood groups. On his birthday June 14<sup>th</sup> "World Blood Donors Day" is celebrated.

After donating the blood, the donors were taken care. First time donors, 1<sup>st</sup>yearstudents who were not 18 years and other students celebrated theblood donation by cutting the cake.
