#### **ARTICLE VI: Governing Law, Jurisdiction & Arbitration**

- ii) In case of any differences, both the parties, shall make all efforts to settle the disputes amicably through mutual discussion and negotiation, failing which, dispute(s) shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator appointed by both the Parties, as per provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including. Language of Arbitration shall be English and place of Arbitration shall be New Delhi, India.
- iii) Subject to the Arbitration Clause, the Courts competent jurisdiction at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of any and all matters pertaining to this MOU.

#### ARTICLE VII: Miscellaneous

- i) This MOU can only be amended in writing by mutual consent of both the Parties.
- ii) This MOU shall come in effect from the date of affixing signature by both the Parties and shall remain valid for a period of One (1) year from that date, subject to any written notice by one party to the other party, expressing its intent to terminate this MOU.
- iii) Either of the Parties, may terminate this MOU by way of 2 (two) months advance notice. In such an event, both the Parties, shall make all endeavours to fulfil their obligations and

### 2.3 Industry Partner:

- Share training specifications, Standard operating procedures/Best Practices for sales, installation and service of various products that can be incorporated in training
- Share the branding guidelines for establishing the COEs.
- Provide equipments and machineries for training at a subsidized rates/donate as CSR grant for setting up the Labs /COEs for training.
- Share the branding guidelines for setting up the Labs /COEs.
- Provide industry experts /resource persons for training faculty and mentoring students during training.
- Facilitate industry visits, internships and on the job training.
- Provide employment services as per the need.
- Facilitate the candidates to setup micro enterprises and appoint them as their last mile sales and service support points.
- Branding and Marketing: Each partner shall strictly follow the branding norms of each 3. other in all branding /marketing platforms.

- Duration: The MOU shall be valid for 5 years from the date of signing.
- No Exclusivity: Both parties shall have right to enter into similar arrangement with any 5. third party for product or service during the term of this Agreement.
- Confidentiality: The Parties agree to keep confidential, the content of this Agreement 6. and any and all information shared with each other and designated confidential. This obligation shall be applicable till the expiry of this Agreement and for 1 year thereafter.
- Termination: Either Party shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement by giving 3 months advance notice in writing. Either Party shall be entitled to terminate this 7. Agreement by giving 3 months notice in case the other Party fails to fulfill its obligations enumerated in this Agreement and upon failure of the other Party to cure such failure within the said 3 months of the said other party being given a written notice of the same by the said Party. However, if this agreement is terminated for any reason by either party by giving the notice in writing or expires after 5 years, the education and financial responsibilities(if any) of both the parties shall continue till the last admitted batch of the students complete the proposed Program.
- Indemnification: Each party shall protect and indemnify the other party against any direct damages, claims, suits, actions, judgments, costs and expenses directly arising out 8. of or in any way connected with any act/omission arising in relation to this Agreement or in case said party fails to fulfill its obligations enumerated in this Agreement Or breach of representation and warranty provided in the agreement.
- Dispute Resolution: All disputes and differences howsoever arising out of or in connection with this agreement shall be mutually discussed and to be settled amicably. 9.
- Severability: In the event that any term, condition, or provision of this MOU is held to be a violation of any applicable law, statute, or regulation the same shall be deemed to be 10. deleted from this MOU and shall be of no force and effect and this MOU shall remain in full force and effect as if such term, condition, or provision had not originally be contained in this MOU.

This Agreement or any rights, obligation under this agreement shall not be assigned by 11. any party to a third party without prior written consent of the other party. However,

each party shall have right to assign this agreement to any of its affiliates, associates, group companies with prior intimation to the other party. Further any party shall have right to sub contract part of its obligation requiring special skill, technology for

fulfillment to third party.

- Warranties: Each Party warrants to other Parties that (i) it has full right, power and authority to enter into this Agreement and carry out its obligations under this - 14. Agreement; (ii) its entry into this Agreement and its performance of its obligations hereunder will: (a) not conflict with Applicable Laws or any agreement by which it is bound; and (b) not infringe the Intellectual Property Rights or other rights of any third party; (c) each party has obtained and shall maintain required approval, permission, consent, from Statutory or other authorities as required to perform obligation under this MOU
  - Legal Notices: Any notice, demand or request under this agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered or sent by Registered Mail to the addresses as indicated in the 15. agreement.
  - Limitation of Liability: Notwithstanding anything contained in these Terms & Conditions, both parties shall in no event be liable for any special, indirect, consequential or 16. incidental damages (including but not limited to damages for loss of business profits, business interruptions, loss of business information, and the like) arising out of this arrangement, agreement, any documents referenced this agreement, or any addenda or amendment hereto.


